

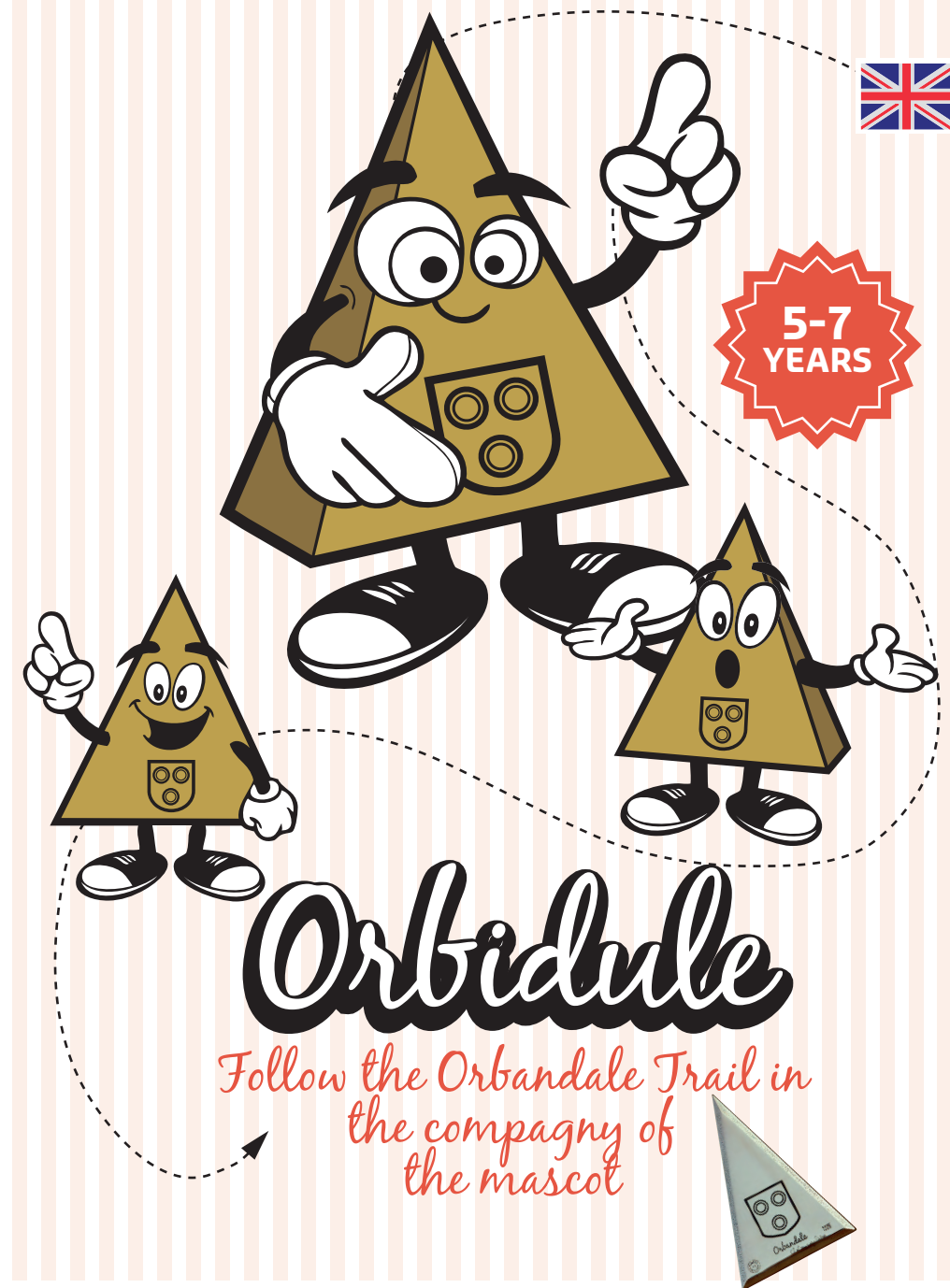
## Chalon-sur-Saône Burgundy concentrated!

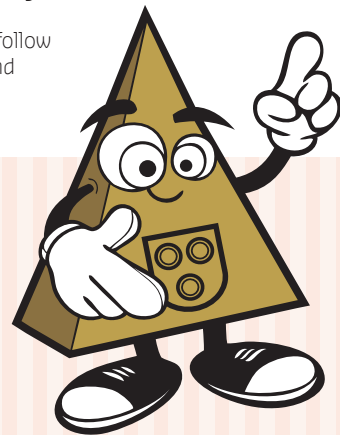


# Orbandale

The questions in red will help you find the answer to the final riddle. As you slowly cross off names, the one that is left will be that of Vivant Denon

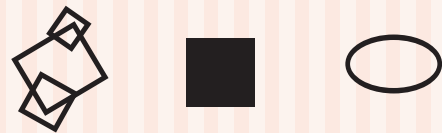

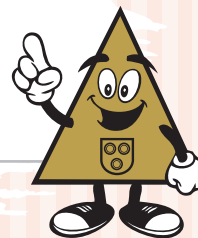
