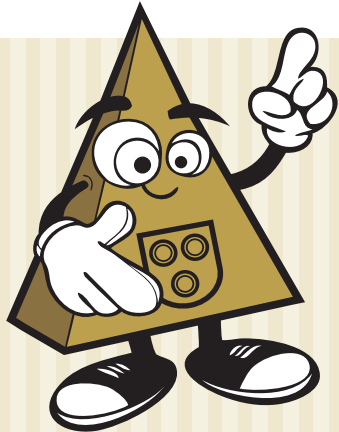


Treasure Hunt on the Orbandale Trail

Numbers in red will help you answer the final puzzle

Nicephore Niepce, who invented photography, was born in Chalon-sur-Saône in 1765 and died in 1833 at Saint-Loup-de-Varennes. A fan of photography, Orbidule has come to Chalon-sur-Saône to follow in the footsteps of the inventor. Following different clues and with the help of the Orbandale Trail (adult version), help Orbidule to find out Nicephore Niepce's first name and the date on which he took the first ever photograph. Write down the answers to the questions with red numbers on the back of this paper.



1 *Port Villiers*
From the Port Villiers you have a nice view of the Ile St Laurent, draw the Doyenné Tower.

2 *Statue of Nicephore Niepce*
You find yourself in front of the statue sculpted by Eugene Guillaume of Nicephore Niepce; what is his day of birth?

3 *The Tourist Office*
Which animals would you have found in the Tourist Office when it was the building for mail and stagecoaches?

4 *Nicephore Niepce Photography Museum*
Draw a picture of a camera :

5 *The Colmont Fusselet Mansion*
What is in the Colmont-Fusselet mansion?

6 *The Tower known as "Coco Louvrier"*
What name would you give to the tower if you had the chance to name it?

7 *St Laurent Bridge*
Puzzle: Very common in ancient Egypt, there are four to be found on the St Laurent Bridge
